Demonstrator Guidelines

- Demonstrators must be willing to engage and educate the public about their craft.
- All crafts must be handmade.
- Demonstrators are welcome to dress in modern or period-appropriate clothing.
- All demonstrators must use only techniques and tools available at least 100 years ago.
 - o Examples – If you transport items in plastic bins, please hide the bins during the demonstrations and use baskets or bowls. If you use store-bought yarn, please remove the tags and rewind it into a ball rather than a machined skein. If you use power tools at home to help drill, please do not bring the power tools for use on-site.
- Items cannot be sold at your table during demonstrations. On the day of the event, you may sell items for consignment in the Heritage Square Gift Shop. - Demonstrations are outside in Heritage and Science Park. Approved participants will be supplied with a tent, table and chairs.
- Please bring all other supplies you will need for your demonstration.
- The time of the demonstration runs from 10:00am to 4:00pm.
- Set-up begins at 9am the day of the event; tear down begins at 3:45pm. Parking will be provided in the Heritage Square garage at 5th and Monroe.
- Heritage Festival will take place rain or shine (with exceptions for extreme weather)
